# **2011 FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION**

- **Ten \$3,000 Scholarships**

Ten Savannah River Remediation (SRR) Family Scholarships, worth a total value of \$30,000, will be awarded in 2011. Winners are selected on the basis of general ability, leadership, scholastic assessment and achievement. Final awards are made by Savannah River Remediation as appropriate; winners will be announced in April 2011.

## **CONDITIONS**

- Scholarship payments are to be applied to any bachelor's degree program at an accredited college or university selected by the recipient and approved by the Company.
- The ten \$3,000 scholarship stipends will be awarded in a single payment in June 2011.
- No restriction is placed on the amount of financial aid received from other sources.

## PROCEDURE

1. Complete the attached application and submit it to the above address by **February 15, 2011**.
2. REGISTER FOR THE REQUIRED SAT REASONING TEST. The ACT, PSAT, or other test results are NOT ACCEPTABLE for this competition. Your high school will have the forms and information you need for these tests or you may register online via The College Board website.

### To be ELIGIBLE for this scholarship, one test is required:

- SAT Reasoning Test (previously SAT I)

You are strongly urged to complete all tests as early as possible. **No test dates later than those listed below are acceptable for this year's competition.** (Check the College Board website at: <http://www.collegeboard.org/index.html> for complete information about the SATs.)

**\*Important: You are only required to take the SAT Reasoning Test to be eligible to apply for the SRR scholarship.**

To ensure receipt of scores by the Scholarship Committee, all applicants must indicate on the SAT Program Form that the scores of the SAT Reasoning Test are to be sent to:

If you have already taken the required test, use the Report Request Form available at your high school, and immediately request the SAT Program to report to **CODE NUMBER 3703** scores of SAT Tests you have previously taken.

3. Complete your part of the counselor's form, detach it from the application and take it to your high school guidance counselor. Your counselor must return the form and transcript to SRR Family Scholarship Program by February 15, 2011.

4. All applicants will be sent confirmation of receipt of their application. Scholarship winners will be announced in April 2011.

**\*Important: This is the correct code for SRR.**

## **ELIGIBILITY**

SRR Family Scholarships are open to sons and daughters of employees of SRR who are in their last year in public, private, home or parochial high schools. Applicants must graduate from high school after NOVEMBER 1, 2010 to be eligible. Last year of high school includes students in the 10th, 11th or 12th grade who will enter or continue college after January 1, 2011 but before January 1, 2012.

To be eligible, the applicant's parent must be employed by SRR for a period of one year or more as of May 1, 2011.

Sons and daughters of American expatriates on temporary SRR service abroad are also eligible under the above conditions. The term "children" includes natural children, adopted children, stepchildren, and legal wards.
