We have staffed our center with personnel who understand the emotions and challenges facing workers in transition. You will find an understanding and compassionate staff that is ready to get started in helping you make your employment transition a productive exercise.

It is important that you make your search for a new job part of your daily activities and you are welcome to utilize our center to perform online job searches, request a counseling session on important job search skills or to access forms or other data needed for submissions for employment benefits from your State.

On your first visit to the center, please bring with you pertinent work histories from your years at SRS, including qualifications and training that you have completed. If you do not have this information we will provide it to you during your initial visit to the transition center.
